PULWAMA MARTYRS DAY

On February 14, 2023, a suicide bomber attacked a convoy comprising a total of 78 buses, in which around 2,500 paramilitary personnel were travelling from Jammu to Srinagar. The explosive-laden vehicle rammed into one of the buses, killing 40 members of the CRPF. On this day, India marks the fourth anniversary of one of the deadliest terror attacks carried out on its security forces, which took place in the Pulwama district of Jammu and Kashmir, where at least 40 Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) personnel lost their lives. India also observes February 14 as a 'Black Day' in remembrance of this tragic incident, which brought the entire nation to a standstill after a suicide bomber from Jaish-e-Mohammed rammed a vehicle full of explosives into the CRPF convoy.
