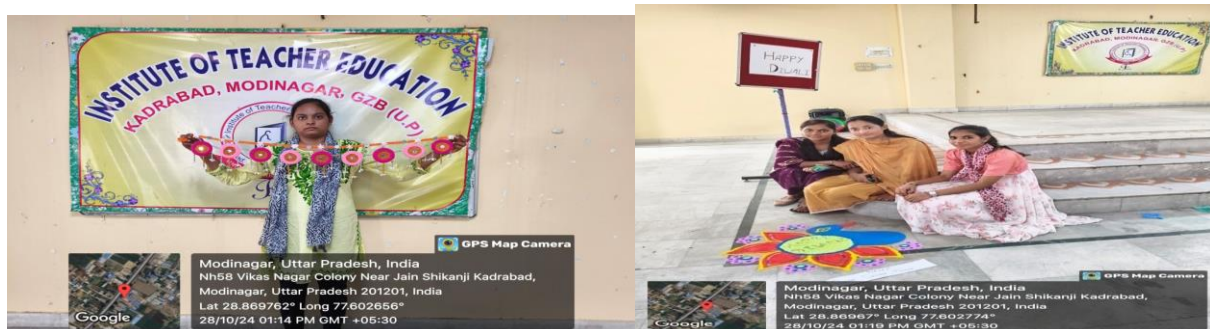
VALUE ADDED COURSE
